



Maintenance of Morsø Outdoor products

The Morsø Forno / Grill Forno / Kamino is made from solid twice-coated cast iron. UHT 600 twice coating is approved for use when in indirect contact with food and has been thoroughly tested and approved to the NORSOK standard.

For everyday cleaning, the cast-iron surfaces can be wiped with a damp cloth or washed with a mild solution of soft soap when the stove is cold. Preferable use demineralised water, as ordinary water can leave limescale. The surface can, however, become slightly oxidised and grey in colour over time, but it can be revitalised it up with Morsø spray paint for outdoor use (UHT 600).

If the surface becomes heavily oxidised and rust patches form, it can be gently cleaned with fine sand paper/emery paper. Make sure the surface is totally clean and dry before applying a new, thin layer of spray paint.

To preserve your Morsø Outdoor products, we recommend storing them in a dry place (indoors) over the winter period.

4. Paint - spray a thin even layer

Maintenance of steel parts

After a long winter, it's a good idea to refresh and treat all your other Morsø Outdoor products.

Morsø Garden and Terra tables

Wash the table well and wipe the surface with cooking oil.

This extends its service life and looks attractive. The stainless steel hangers on the side of the table can be freshened up using an abrasive sponge (grain 180). Rust spots can be polished off gently and, after washing, treated with cooking oil.



Outdoor tools

For example, the ash scraper, fire tongs and Forno door can be easily polished with an abrasive sponge (grain 180) and then treated with oil to look as good as new.
